## 2084 Vine Street

Several neighbors have noted that the location at 2084 Vine has been having a high number of LAPD responding to calls. Now there are constant issues with break-ins.

Cameras on the property are alerting LAPD when the cameras capture trespassers, and they have responded, but by the time they arrive the people have cleared out.

Deborah spoke with CD4 and they suggested that she reach out to Building & Safety. She said that LAPD told her that the property owner is not cooperating with them – and won't provide footage from the security cameras.

Deborah has the point person at Building & Safety info she will share.  
Alexa will reach out to LAPD.

This house had been previously illegally (un permitted and unsafe) altered and used as a short-term rental. Building & Safety removed the Certificate of Occupancy and no one should be on the property unless it's the owner or the owner's workers to fix the issues.

#### **2048 Holly Drive**

This house has been vacant & boarded up for quite a while.  
The owners have been approved to do a small lot subdivision. They plan to demolish the existing house and build multi units (5, 3-story SFD). The application for the demolition permit is pending (as of 03/12/2026).

Jodi has spoken to the property owners and asked that neighbors be allowed to remove any period details inside the house before they tear it down. We need to watch for the notices for the demo dates.
